### **A New Edition of the Roman Missal is being introduced this year. But what is the Roman Missal?**

The term "Missal" refers to the book that contains all the prayers & instructions for the celebration of mass. The Scripture readings used at Mass are also part of the Missal but are published separately in the 'Lectionary'. The Missal is first written in Latin & this text is then translated into the particular language for the people. In this way, while the Mass may be celebrated in many languages across the Roman Catholic world, it is the same core Latin text that is being prayed by the Church. In Ireland we have been using our current Missal since St. Patrick's Day 1975. A new edition, the Third Edition of the Roman Missal, is coming into use in Ireland & in other English speaking countries in Autumn 2011.
