JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

This Sunday 13th Oct, Pope Francis will preside at the Canonisation of John Henry Newman. Born in London in 1801, Cardinal Newman a Protestant was later ordained an Anglican priest. In 1842 Newman withdrew from public life to live a monastic life, writing & reflecting until 3 years later when he was received into the Catholic Church. Ordained a priest in 1846 he wrote many books, prayers etc. In 1879 Pope Leo XIII made Newman a Cardinal. He died in 1890 & is now recognised among the Saints.
