ST. PATRICK'S DAY
 Tuesday 17th March is the Feast of St. Patrick our National Apostle.

ST PATRICK
 the patron saint of Ireland was born in the second half of the 4th century. Despite his family involvement in the church, young Patrick was not a believer. His life was ordinary, and completely unexceptional, until the age of 16. Patrick was kidnapped and sold into slavery in Ireland. During this period, he became increasingly religious. After a vision led him to stow away on a boat bound for Britain, Patrick escaped back to his family. There he had a dream that the Irish were calling him back to Ireland to tell them about God. For 20 years he travelled all over Ireland baptising people and establishing monasteries, schools and churches as he went. He died, on 17 March 46 and was buried in Downpatrick, Co Down.
