RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES:

As a follow up to Bishop Fintan's Pastoral letter & after feedback from Pastoral Council members it was acknowledged that it would be great to see Churches reopened. The feed back also highlighted the responsibility we have as a church community to ensure the care of each other through putting in place the proper safety & hygiene guidelines. Our church will re-open on Monday 25th May on a phased basis. In practice this will mean we will open for private prayer on Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 12 Noon to 3 p.m. on those days. All who wish to visit the church on those days are very welcome, but we also urge people to be responsible in following proper safety guidelines. We ask you to observe the following guidelines during your visit—Enter the Church by the Main Door Only & Exit by the Side Doors;
Use Hand Sanitiser at Main Entrance & at Exits again; Observe Social Distance; Sit in designated FRONT SEATS only in the Church; If lighting a Candle take light from Big Candle which will be Lighting- Use Hand Sanitiser afterwards while observing Social Distance; If praying the Stations of the Cross, pray them while sitting. Be responsible in our care for each other. Please respect the Seating Plan of the Church
12 Persons in Church at a time. We will revisit the opening hours & days after two weeks, as we continue to move forward.
