We ask you to observe the following guidelines during your visit—

Mon, Wed, Fri- 12 – 3p.m. Sun. 1-4 p.m.

Enter the Church by the Main Door Only & Exit by the Side Doors;

Use Hand Sanitiser at Main Entrance & at Exits again; Observe Social Distance;

Sit in designated FRONT SEATS only in the Church;
If lighting a Candle take light from Big Candle which will
be Lighting-

Use Hand Sanitiser afterwards while observing Social Distance;

If praying the Stations of the Cross, pray them while sitting.
