RE-OPENING CHURCH FOR PUBLIC MASS:

As and from Monday 29th June Churches can re-open provided they are safe spaces for the celebration of Public Mass again but with limited numbers of 50 persons.

In the light of this Monmore Church will NOT reopen at the moment & so we are putting the following Mass Schedule in place

Monday-Thursday- 10 a.m. Friday- 7 p.m.

Saturday- 7 p.m. Sunday- 8.30 a.m.; 10 a.m.; 12 Noon

In order to organise in a safe manner we will have a ticket system for Masses on Friday, Saturday and Sunday & this information will also assist with contact tracing if necessary. Due to limited numbers we ask that you chose <u>ONE MASS</u> <u>OVER THE WEEKEND FROM FRIDAY EVENING TO</u> SUNDAY so that we can facilitate as many people as possi-

ble. Your ticket will cover your commitment to be at the Mass of choice on the particular date & time you have chosen. Two tickets per family unit.

TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM THE COMMUNITY CENTRE ON WEDNESDAY 1ST JULY &

FRIDAY 3RD JULY FROM 10AM—12NOON ONLY As we are limited to a maximum of 50 persons in Church all in attendance must show their ticket on arrival to the stewards who in turn will show you to your seat. We ask you to arrive early so as to help keep safety a priority and be patient with the stewards.

We can appreciate this is very different and may be difficult for some. We are conscious that many may not be ready to gather in a public place so please feel under no obligation to join us for Mass.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is suspended at this time but those who are concerned or anxious about this can attend on any other day and also through joining via webcam or parish radio link as you are already doing.

We thank you for your continued support. We look forward to welcoming you again when you feel comfortable to do so.
