## RE-OPENING CHURCH FOR PUBLIC MASS:

Our Church is now re-open for the celebration of Public Mass again but with limited numbers of 50 persons. Our Mass Schedule is as follows

Monday-Thursday- 10 a.m.

Friday- 7 p.m.

Saturday- 7 p.m.

Sunday- 8.30 a.m.; 10 a.m.; 12 Noon

In order to organise in a safe manner we will have a ticket system for Masses on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. We ask that you contact the parish office and indicate the Mass of choice you wish to attend. Due to limited numbers we ask that you chose ONE MASS OVER THE WEEKEND FROM FRIDAY EVENING TO SUNDAY so that we can facilitate as many people as possible. Your ticket will cover your commitment to be at the Mass of choice on the particular date & time you have chosen. Two tickets per family unit.

TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM THE COMMUNITY CENTRE ON **Wed & Fri 10.30am –**

**12noon.** As we are limited to a maximum of 50 persons in Church all in attendance must show their ticket on arrival to the stewards who in turn will show you to your seat. We ask you to arrive early so as to help keep safety a priority and be patient with the stewards. We can appreciate this is very different and may be difficult for some. We are conscious that many may not be ready to gather in a public place so please feel under no obligation to join us for Mass. The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is suspended at this time but those who are concerned or anxious about this can attend on any other day and also through joining via webcam or parish radio link as you are already doing. We thank you for your continued support. We look forward to welcoming you again when you feel comfortable to do so.

## PRACTICAL GUIDELINES as we Re-OPEN our Church for Public Worship & Sacraments.

On arrival at church PRESENT your Ticket to the Steward at the Door. Ticket presented admits ONE PERSON for Mass. Sanitise your hands at the stations in the inside Porch. People need to maintain social distance at all times. Wait for steward to show you to your seat. People must sit in seat assigned to them for that Mass. Seats will be filled from the Front. Once in Seat, sit and stand during Mass. DO NOT KNEEL. Holy Communion will be brought to you in your place. Reception of Holy Communion on the HAND only At End of Mass seats will empty from the back. Sanitise your hands at the stations as you leave church. Please do not congregate as you leave the church.
