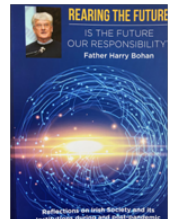
CHRISTMAS MASS BOUQUETS

Their influence is still among us.

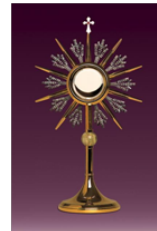
There is nothing stronger or more helpful
