#### ST. SENAN

Next Monday 8th March is the Feast of St. Senan. Senan offered the light of hope to the people of West Clare in difficult times. To help rekindle the light of hope in our times we invite you to light a candle of hope and place it on the window.

#### PRAYER TO ST. SENAN

Lord, when a darkened sky surrounds me, Let me find hope; In quiet hurts & sorrows, Let me find hope; In my struggling hours & moments, Let me find hope; To those whose hearts are weary, Let me reach out with hope;

was born in Corca Bhaisin, County Clare about 488. It seems that Senan's family had two farms, one at Moylough and the other at a place called Tracht Termainn. He placed himself under the Abbot Cassidan and took the monastic habit. Cassidan was originally from South-west Cork. Senan then went to the Monastery of Kilmanagh (Ossory) to continue his preparations for the religious life. Returning to Ireland, St. Senan established a church and monastery at Inniscarra, in Cork. He then moved back to his native district. He began his

work on the islands of the Fergus. He crossed to Mutton Island, then to Bishop's Island, south of Kilkee. Finally, about 534, he established himself at Scattery, the low green island about a mile off the coast from Kilrush. St. Senan is said to have died on March 8th, 544. The river Shannon is believed to be named after him. His patron day on March 8th was an important day of pilgrimage to Inis Cathaig. He is buried on Scattery Island, probably in Temple Senan.
