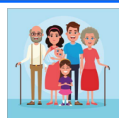

The Priests of the diocese will be on their Annual Diocesan In-Service in Loughrea beginning on the evening of Sunday the 15th October until the afternoon of Wednesday the 18th October. This is a very important time for priests to be together and to engage in on-going personal and pastoral development. It is also a time for the priests of the diocese to respond to the Synodal invitation of Pope Francis for priests to engage ministry in a discerned and reflective way. It is hoped that all priests in active ministry would be completely free from pastoral engagements during this time. I am asking that funerals would be suspended until priests return from their in-service on Wednesday afternoon. Fr. Oliver Ryan will only be available for 10 a.m. Mass Monday-Wednesday.
