**FEAST OF ST. BLAISE** Sat 3<sup>rd</sup>Feb is the Feast of St. Blaise. It is a day traditionally associated with the Blessing of Throats as we celebrate the life and ministry of St. Blaise who tradition tells us, saved the life of a boy from choking. Blessing of Throats will take place after Mass on Saturday evening 3<sup>rd</sup>& at Masses on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> Feb.

**CANDLEMAS** Friday 2<sup>nd</sup>Feb, Presentation of the Lord is also known as the Feast of Candlemas. It is associated with the blessing of candles. Candles for use in the home & church should be left on the front seats of the church & will be blessed at mass that morning. (If possible <u>Wisley Candles for Church use</u> & <u>Lalor Candles for Home use</u>) Faith in the Church has traditionally been regarded as a light. At baptism a lighted candle represents the faith story the newly baptised child has become part of. We use them in our liturgies down through the ages.
