We thank you for the very generous response to the Pope's Appeal for the Holy Land. The collection came to €1,631. The Diocese will collate the offerings of all Parishes and see to their transmission to Rome for application for the works of the Church in Israel, Palestine and Jordan. The Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem is a body of Knights and Dames specially commissioned by the Holy Father to support the Christians and the Christian presence in the Holy Land. Each Knight and Dame undertakes:-

1. To live a Christian life in fidelity to the Holy Father
2. To make a significant annual donation to the needs of the Christians and Christian Institutions in the Holy Land
